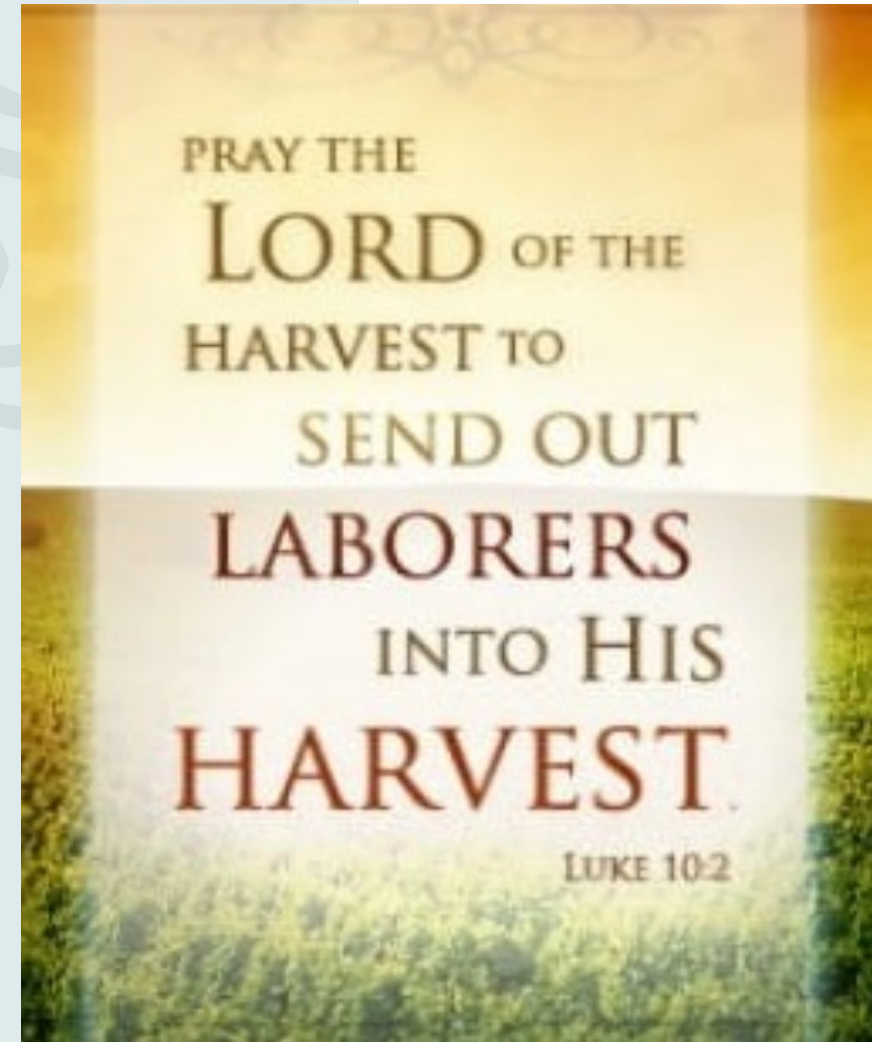

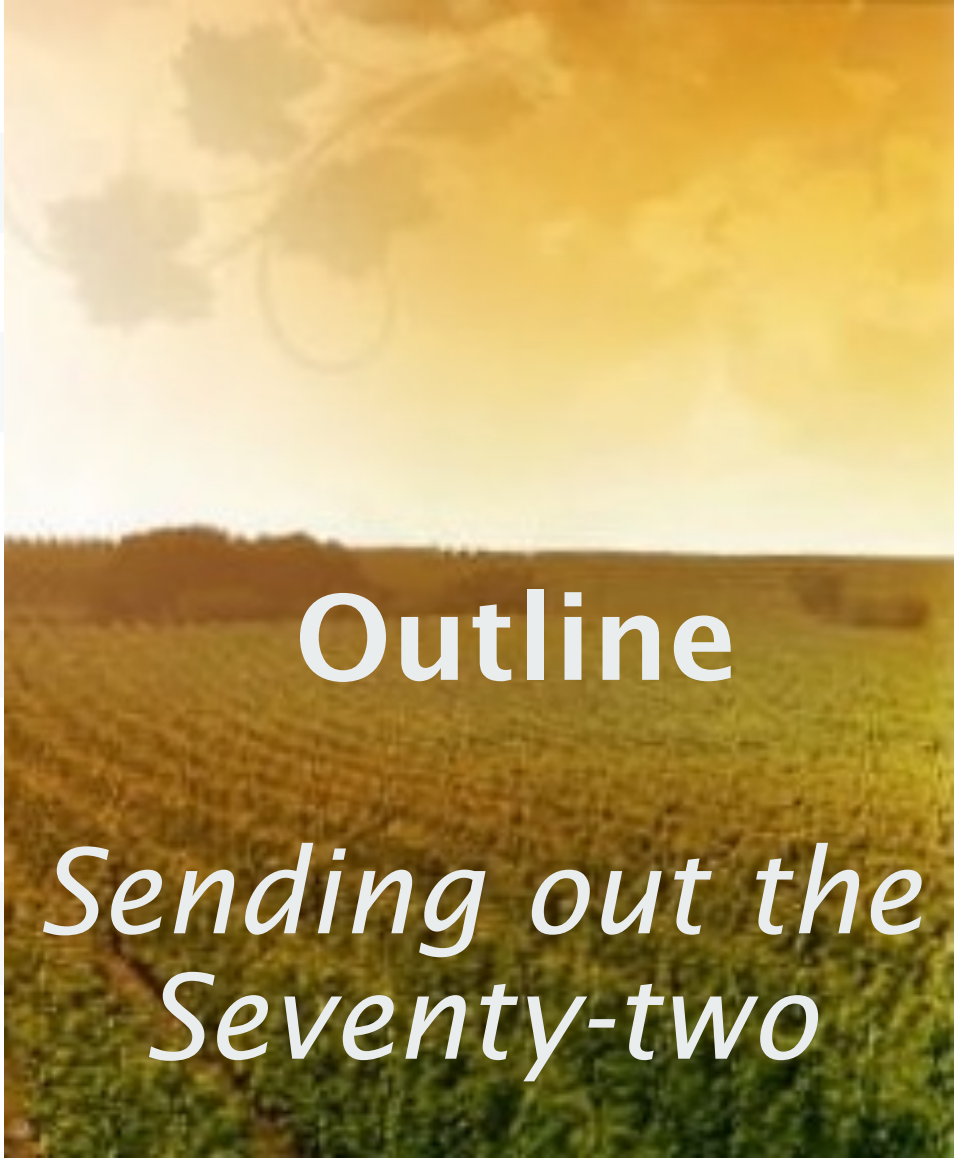

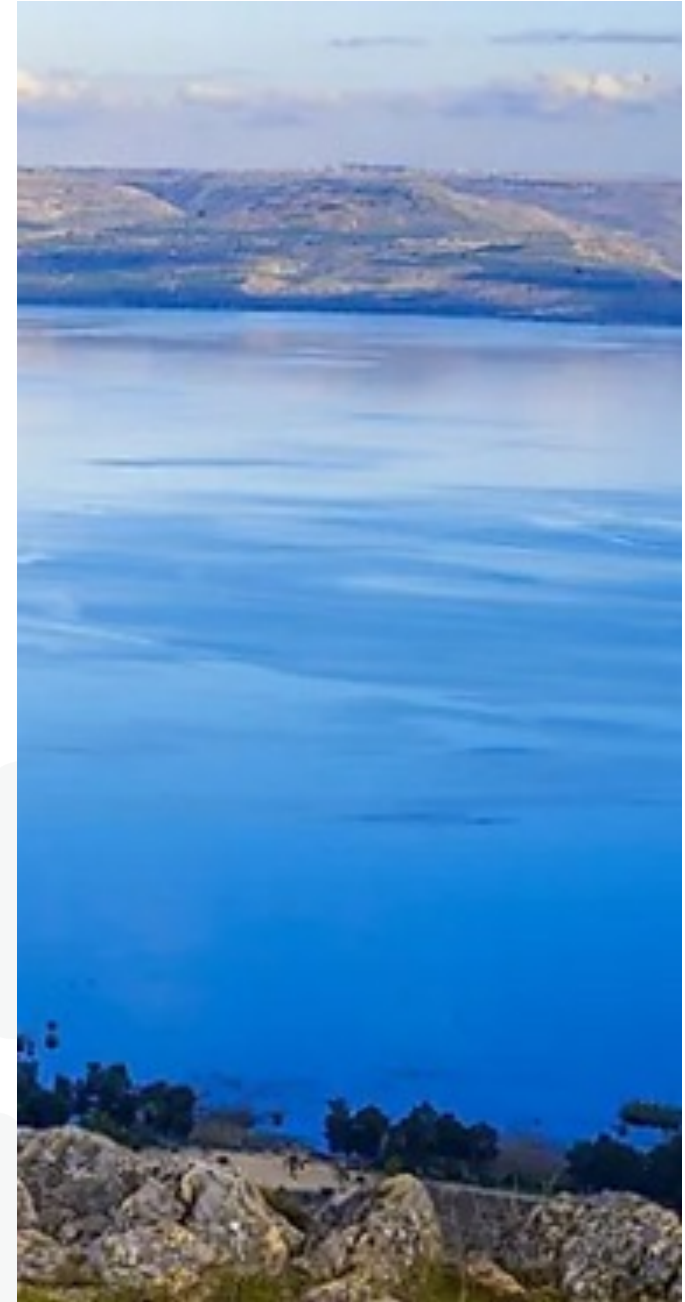

Jesus' Sending

Luke 10:1-16

¹ After this the Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them two by two ahead of him to every town and place where he was about to go. ² He told them, “The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field. ³ Go! I am sending you out like lambs among wolves. ⁴ Do not take a purse or bag or sandals; and do not greet anyone on the road.





⁵ “When you enter a house, first say, ‘Peace to this house.’ ⁶ If someone who promotes peace is there, your peace will rest on them; if not, it will return to you. ⁷ Stay there, eating and drinking whatever they give you, for the worker deserves his wages. Do not move around from house to house.

⁸ “When you enter a town and are welcomed, eat what is offered to you. ⁹ Heal the sick who are there and tell them, ‘The kingdom of God has come near to you.’



¹⁰ But when you enter a town and are not welcomed, go into its streets and say, ¹¹ ‘Even the dust of your town we wipe from our feet as a warning to you. Yet be sure of this: The kingdom of God has come near.’ ¹² I tell you, it will be more bearable on that day for Sodom than for that town.

¹³ “Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the miracles that were performed in you had been performed in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago, sitting in sackcloth and ashes. ¹⁴ But it will be more bearable for Tyre and Sidon at the judgment than for you. ¹⁵ And you, Capernaum, will you be lifted to the heavens? No, you will go down to Hades.

Harvest & Victory

- ✓ Plentiful!
 - ✓ On the way to Jerusalem
 - ✓ Anticipating victory
 - ✓ Kingdom connected!
 - ✓ Peace bringers & healers!
- "... sent them two by two ahead of him to every town and place where he was about to go."*



Humanity

- ✓ Workers needed
- ✓ God-ordained, but human-oriented
- ✓ Trust God—no provisions!
- ✓ Keep it simple...

“⁷ Stay there, eating and drinking whatever they give you, for the worker deserves his wages. Do not move around from house to house.”

**Vulnerability, Resistance,
Coming Judgment**



Vulnerability & Resistance

- ❖ Like lambs among wolves!
- ❖ Some will not receive them
- ❖ Warnings to give...

¹¹ 'Even the dust of your town we wipe from our feet as a warning to you. Yet be sure of this: The kingdom of God has come near.'



Coming Judgment

- ❖ Jesus emphasizes this...
¹² I tell you, it will be more bearable on that day for Sodom than for that town.
- ❖ The disciples are equally warned to be diligent—perhaps some were from Chorazin and Capernaum...

¹³ “Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the miracles that were performed in you had been performed in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago, sitting in sackcloth and ashes. ¹⁴ But it will be more bearable for Tyre and Sidon at the judgment than for you. ¹⁵ And you, Capernaum, will you be lifted to the heavens? Coming Judgment

- ❖ We know from history that the Romans destroyed all
- ❖ But a Day is coming
...Harvest is also Rescue
- ❖ When Jesus comes, the Kingdom is near...
- ❖ Healing is the better choice

¹⁷ The seventy-two returned with joy and said, “Lord, even the demons submit to us in your name.”

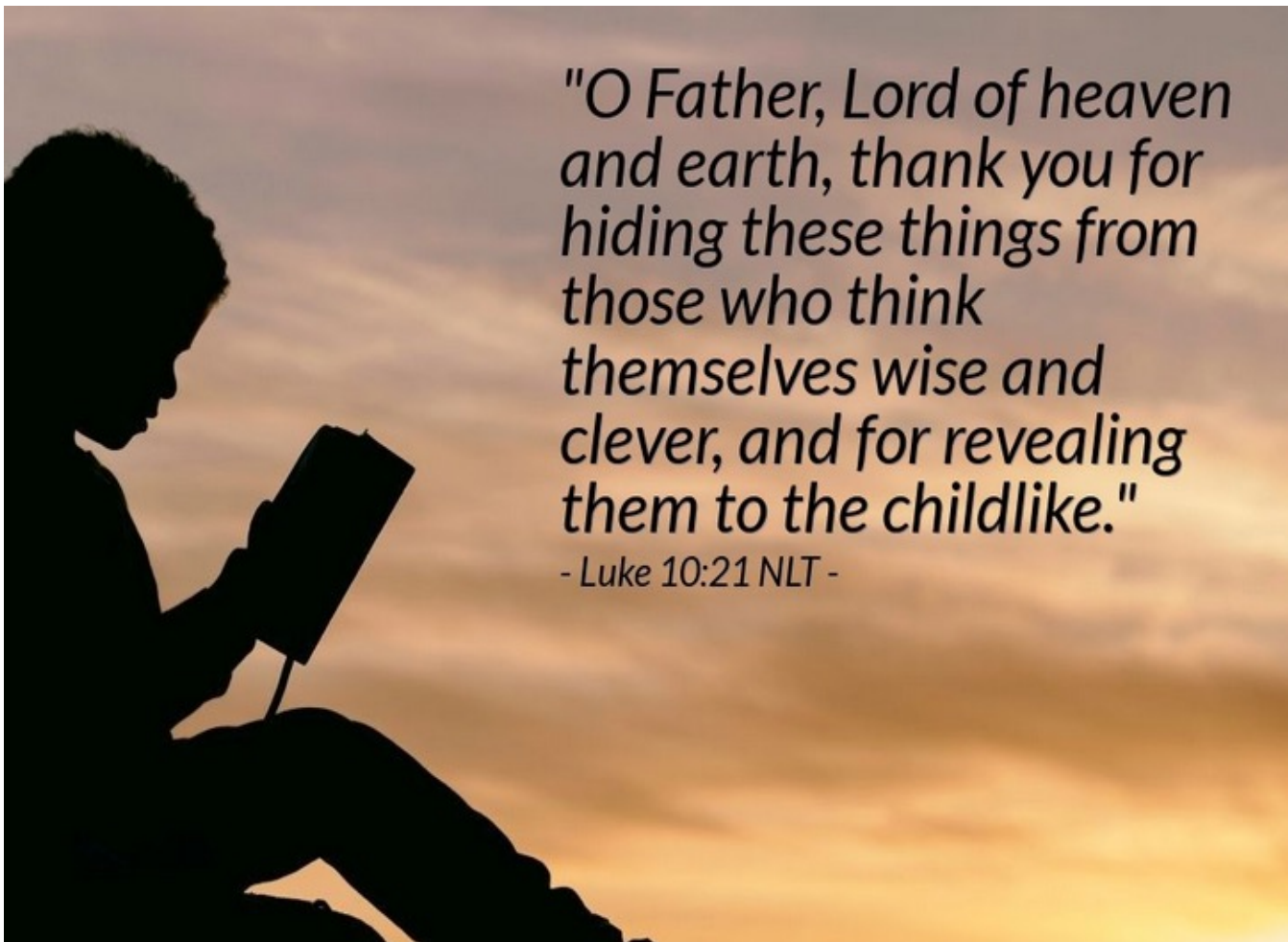

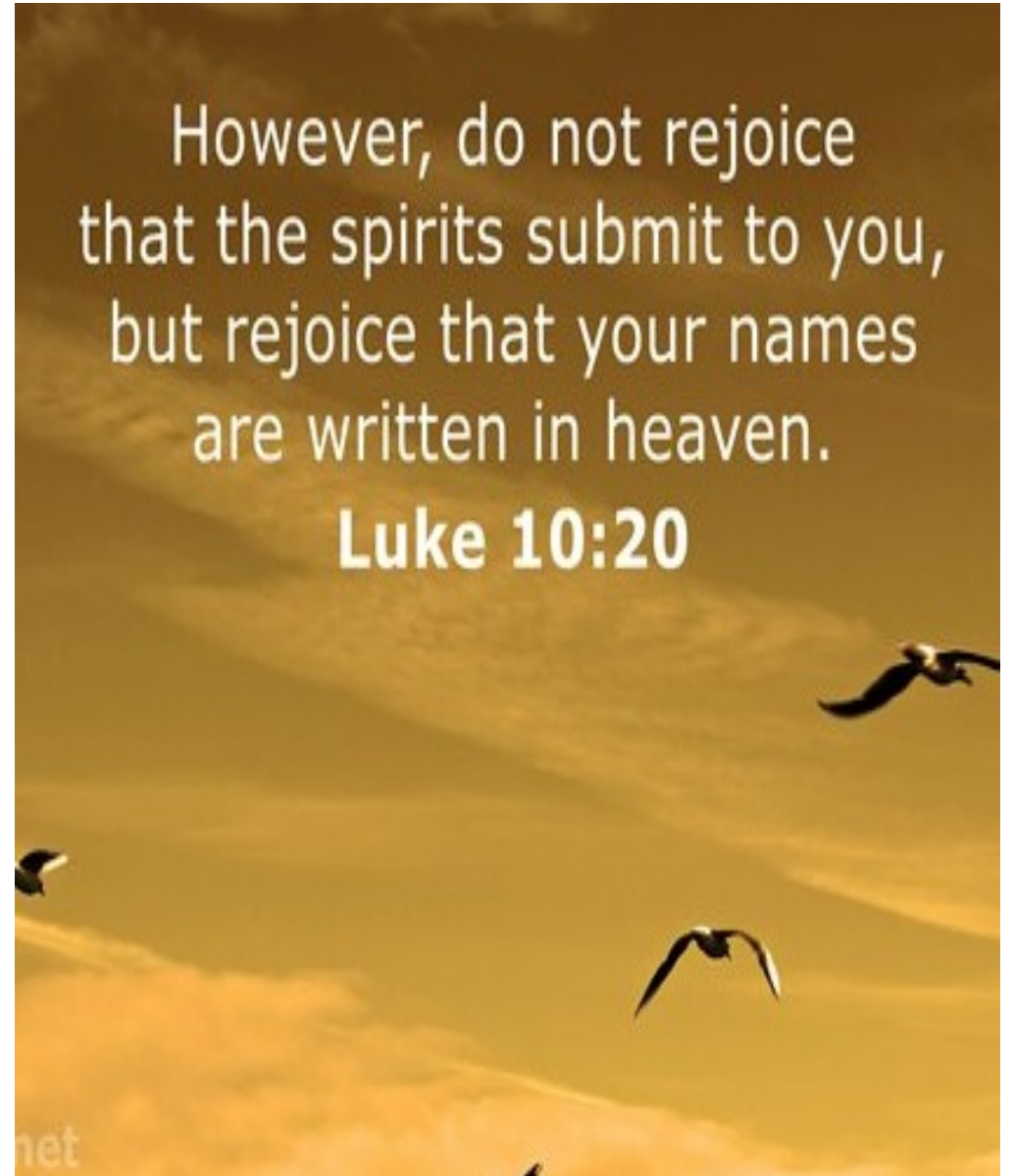
**Authority, Fellowship,

Authority

- ✓ Jesus is victorious!
- ✓ God is pleased with us!
- ✓ Satan's power is fading—
Jesus has complete authority
- ✓ The value of child-like faith
- ✓ They go out as lambs, but
tread on snakes and
scorpions...

Luke 10:20



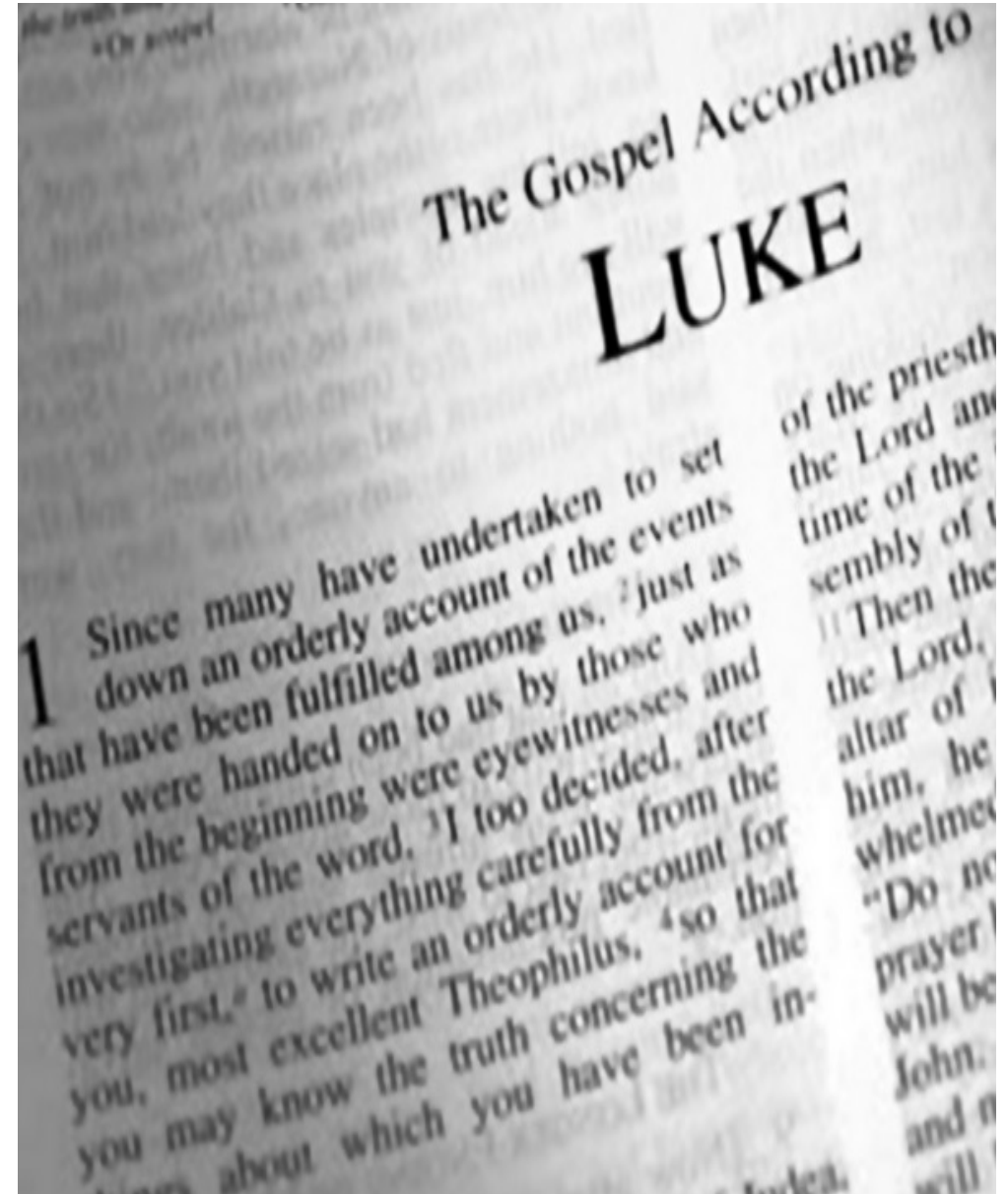
Fellowship

- ✓ vv. 21-22 is a remarkable revelation of the Trinity
- ✓ The Father-Son fellowship
- ✓ Sovereignty shared
- ✓ Jesus can choose to reveal the Father to humanity...
- ✓ *“...those to whom the Son chooses to reveal him.”*

All things have
been handed over to
Me by My Father,
and no one knows
who the Son is
except the Father,
and who the Father
is except the Son,
and anyone to
whom the Son wills
to reveal Him.

Revelation

- ✓ Jesus now turns to his disciples to enlighten them
- ✓ *They are seeing and hearing what prophets and kings searched for!*
- ✓ Do we realize that today?
- ✓ Approval, fellowship, salvation—all are in Jesus

Q~ Is this only 2000 years ago?

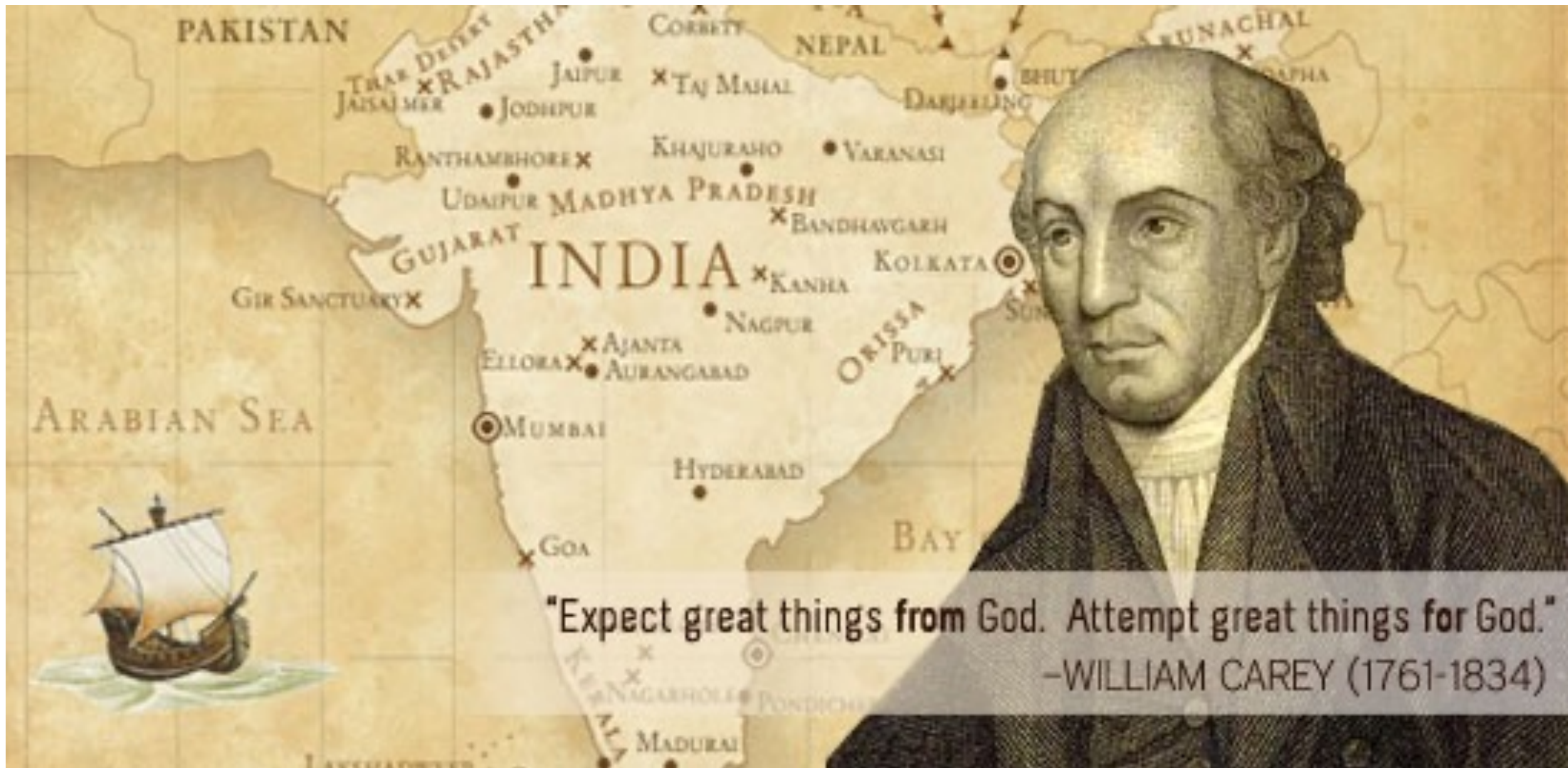
Q~ Have we heard Jesus' ambassador?
