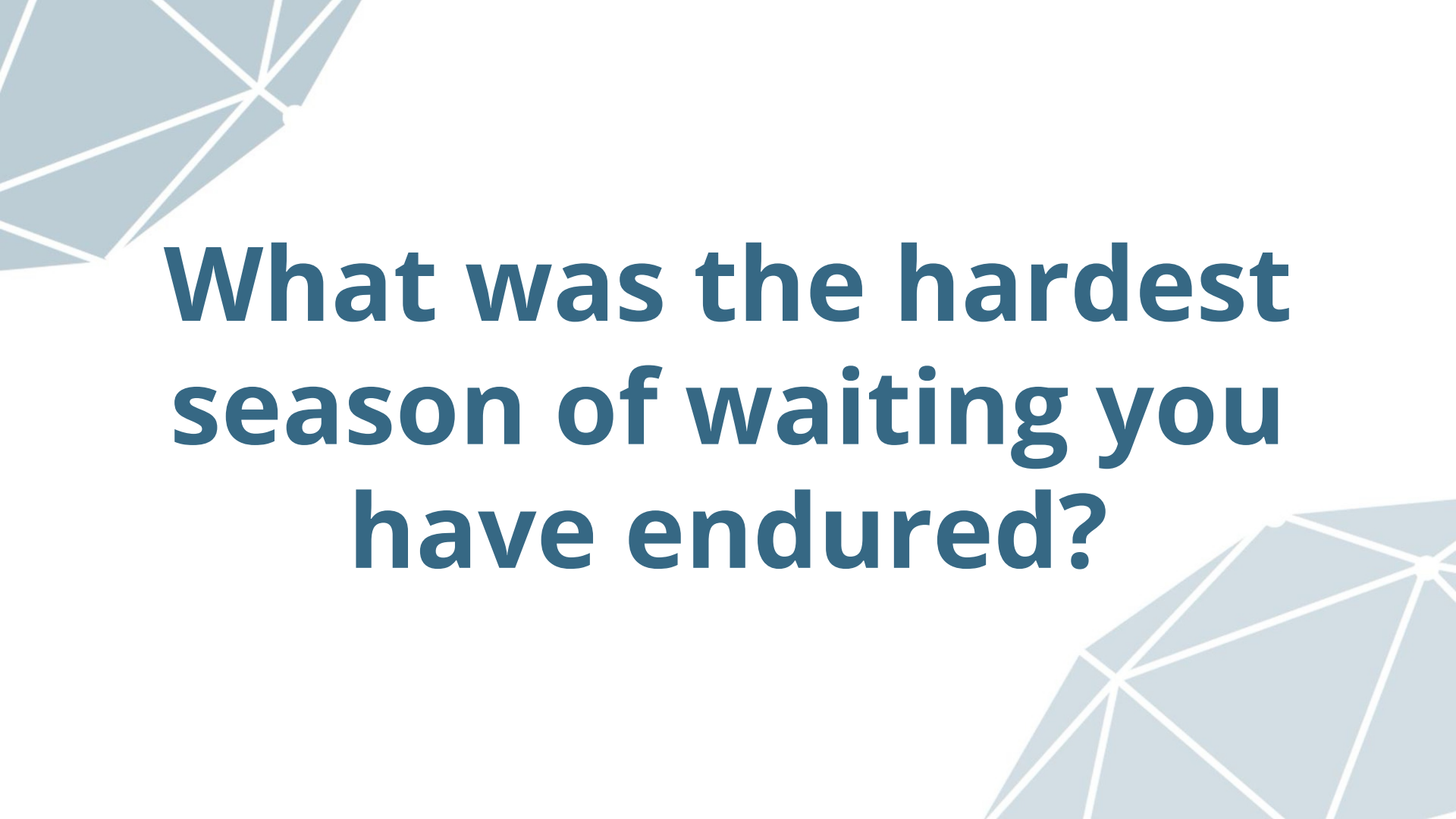




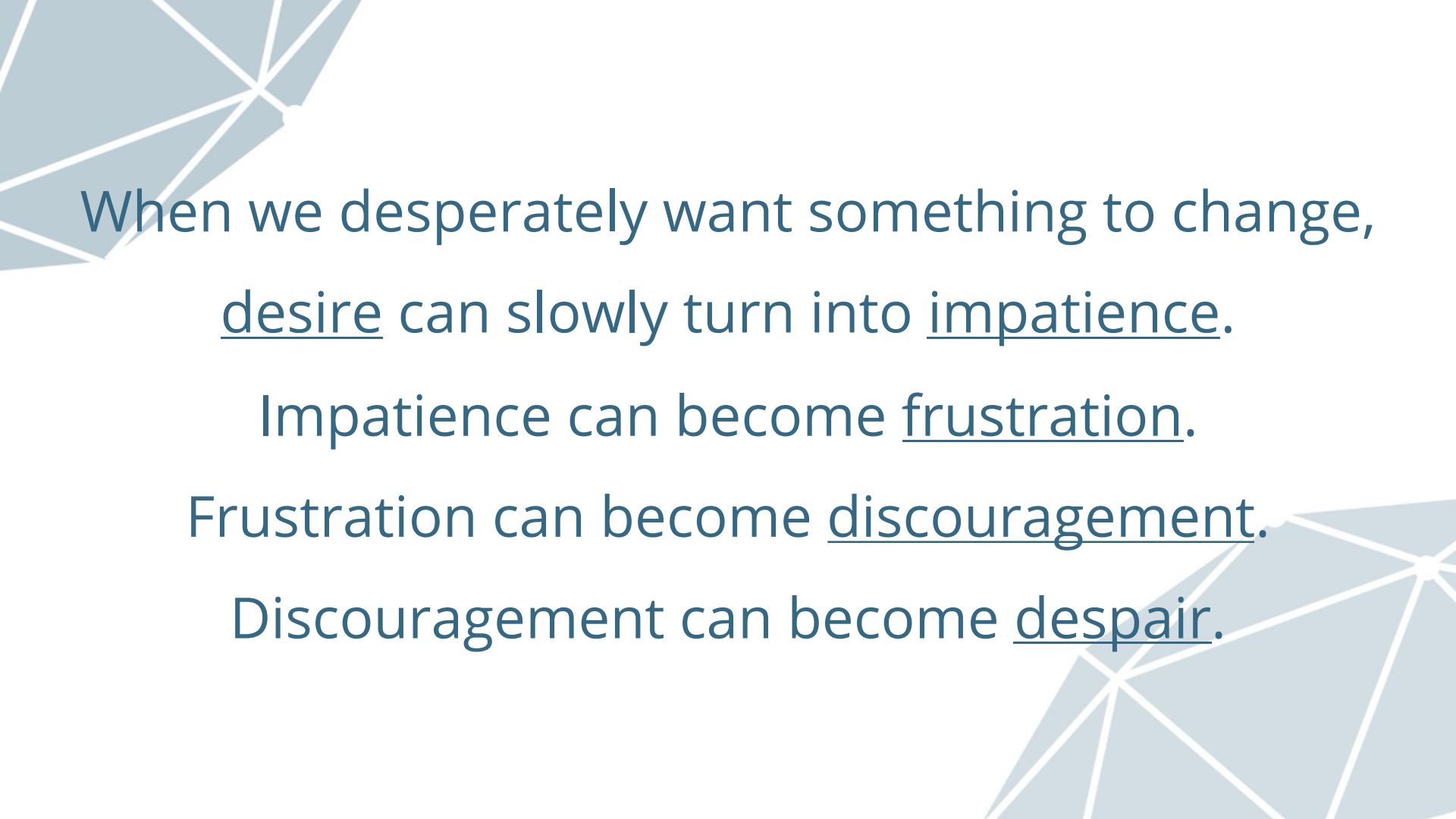

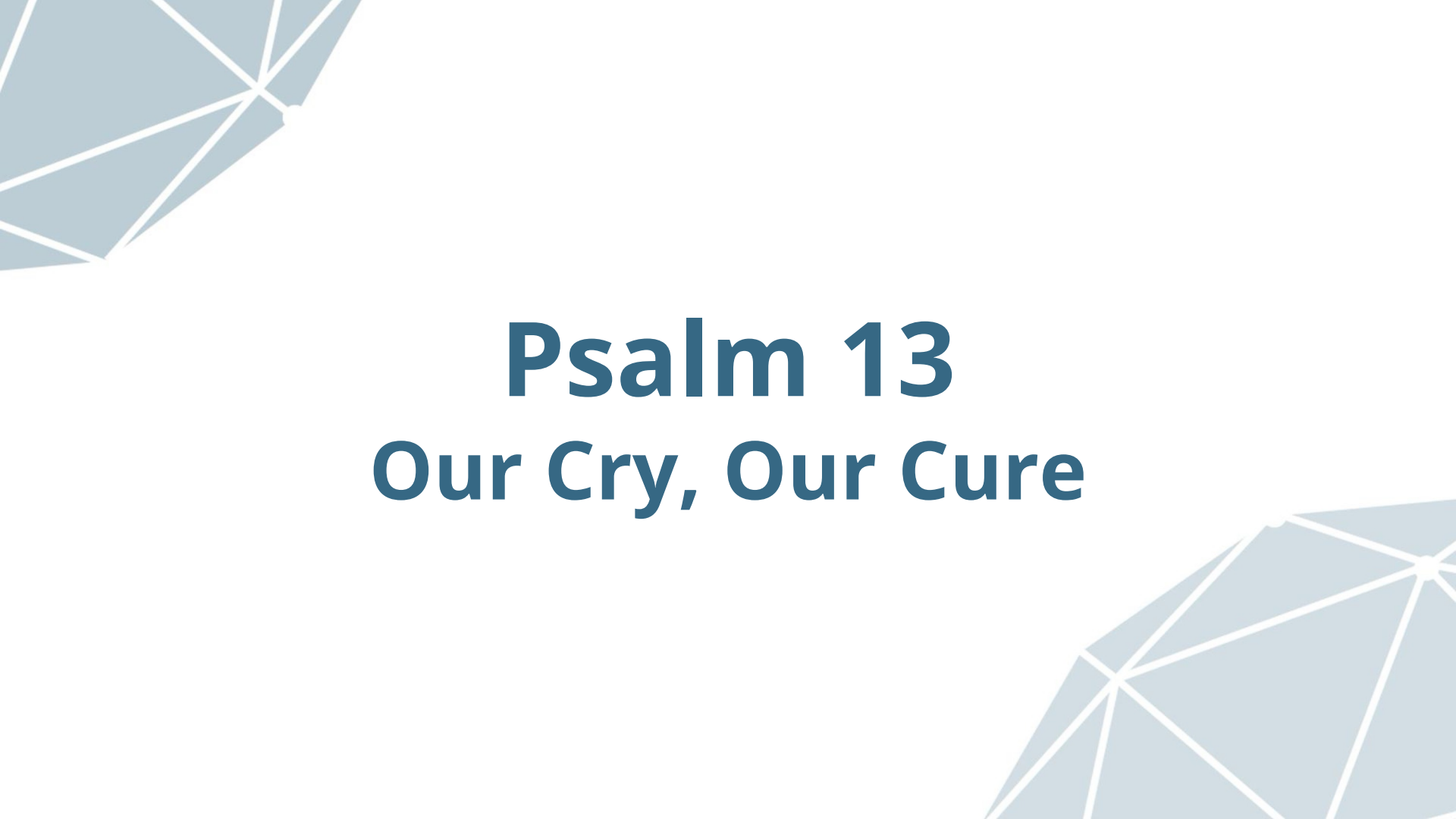


When we desperately want something to change,

Impatience can become frustration.

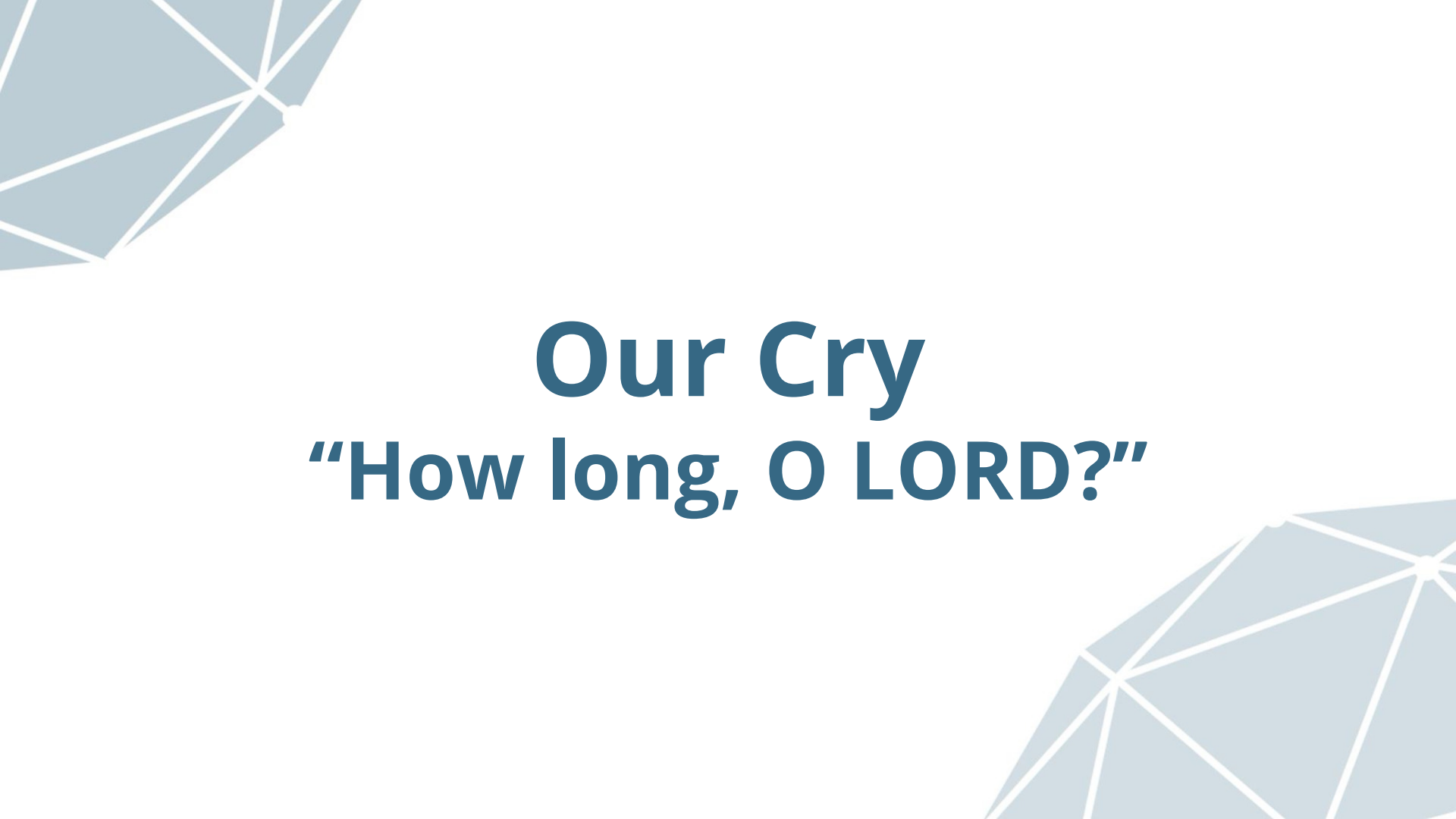
Frustration can become discouragement.
